



A Note from Mrs. Nicoles, School Counselor

April is Child Abuse Prevention Month: Parenting can be frustrating at times for any parent, but as adults we need to remember that children are greatly affected by what we say and do. All children need a nurturing place to grow and know they are safe. Children learn from our examples and often treat others in the world the way they are treated. It is easy to find yourself

in an argument with your child, but remember that it takes two to argue! Power struggles do not solve anything and even create more of a problem than when you started. Try to say “yes” to children more often than “no.” For example, if your child wants to play outside but has homework to complete say, “Yes, as soon as you finish your homework.” Try to give choices as

much as possible to try and make them feel more in control, “You may either clean your room now, or after dinner.” When asking for tasks to be completed, be flexible with minor details. No one will ever say being a parent is easy, but there is NO EXCUSE for child abuse!

Yummy granola bars you can make at home!

2 cups rolled oats, ½ Cup shredded coconut, ½ cup honey, 2 tablespoons creamy peanut butter, 1 teaspoon vanilla extract, 1/8 teaspoon salt Preheat oven 325°F. Grease a 9 inch square baking dish. Spread oats and coconut evenly across the baking sheet. Toast oats and coconut in preheated oven until browned, about 10 minutes; transfer to a large mixing bowl. Mix honey, peanut butter, vanilla extract and salt in a saucepan over medium-low heat. Cook and stir until smooth. Pour the honey mixture over the oats and coconut; stir to coat. Spread the mixture evenly into the prepared baking dish. Bake in preheated oven until beginning to dry, about 15 minutes, for crunchy granola bars, less if you like them chewy. Cool completely before cutting.


